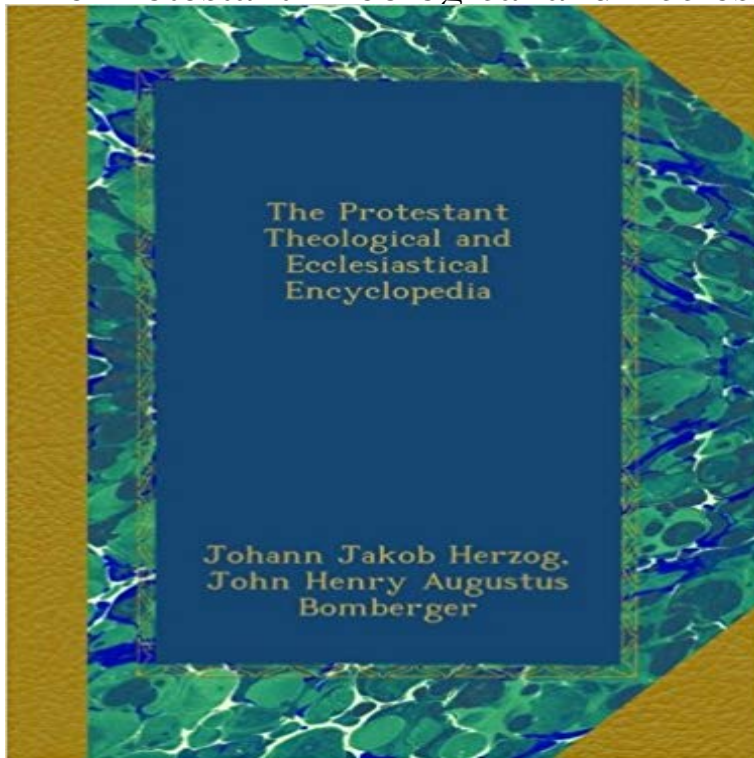


# The Protestant Theological and Ecclesiastical Encyclopedia
