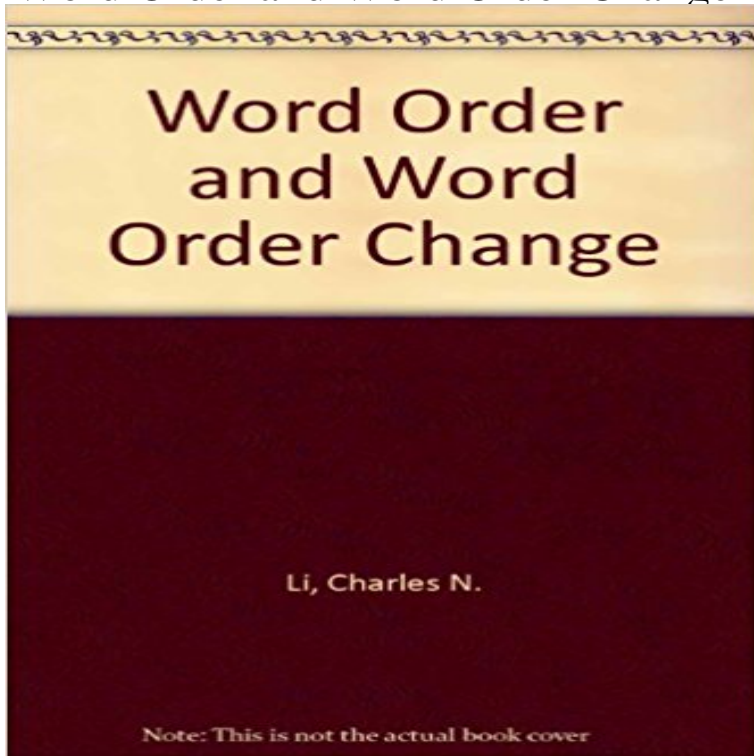


## Word Order and Word Order Change
