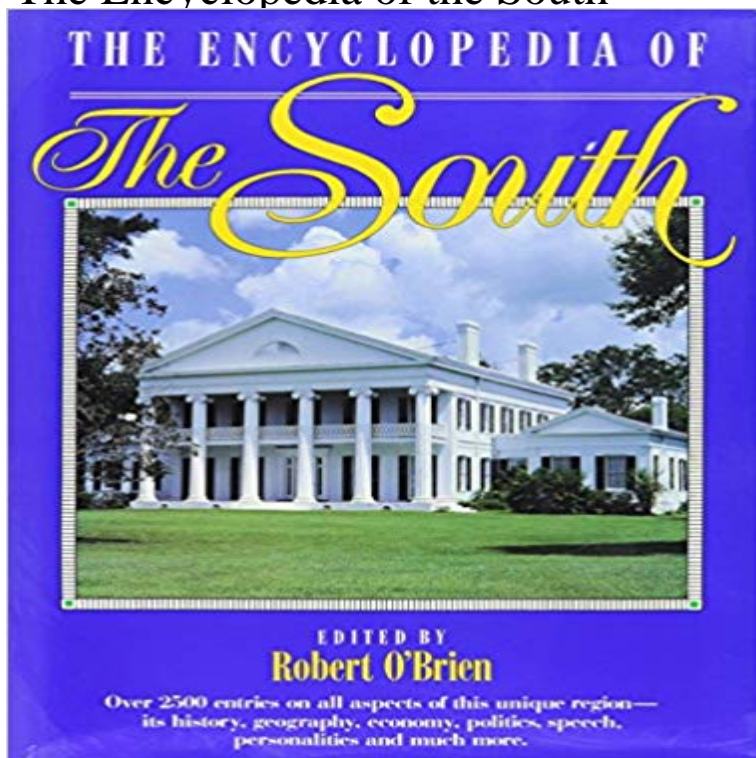


## The Encyclopedia of the South
