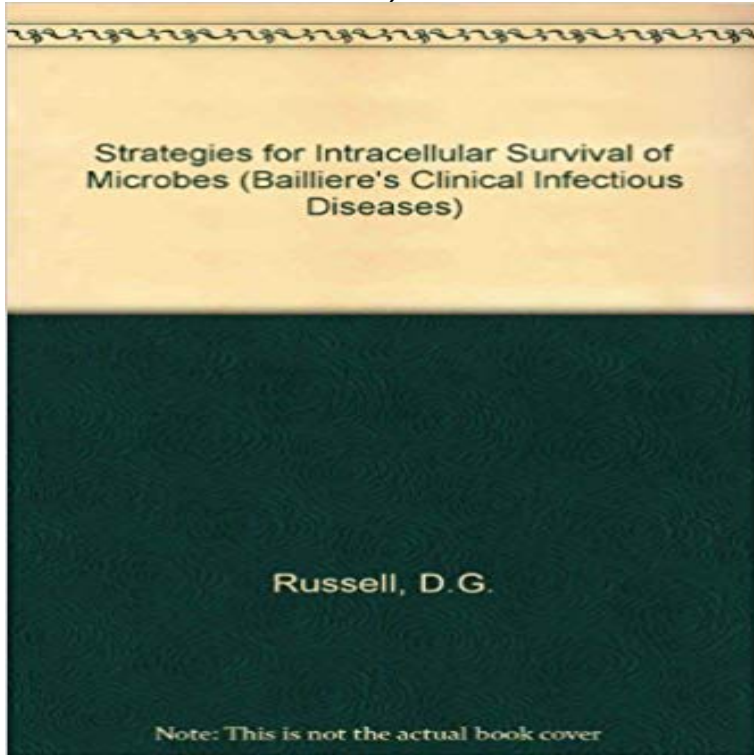


Strategies for Intracellular Survival of Microbes (Baillieres Clinical Infectious Diseases)
