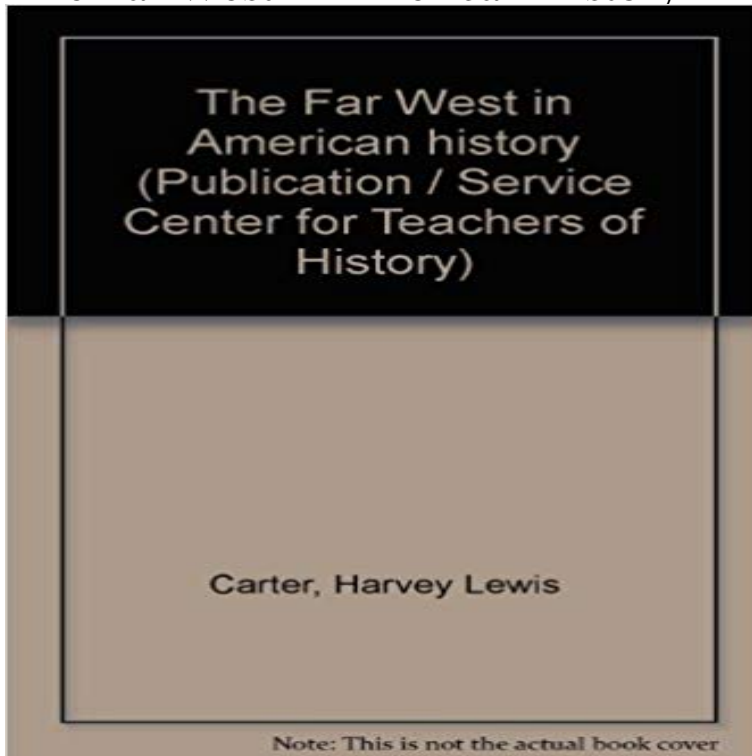


## The Far West in American History
