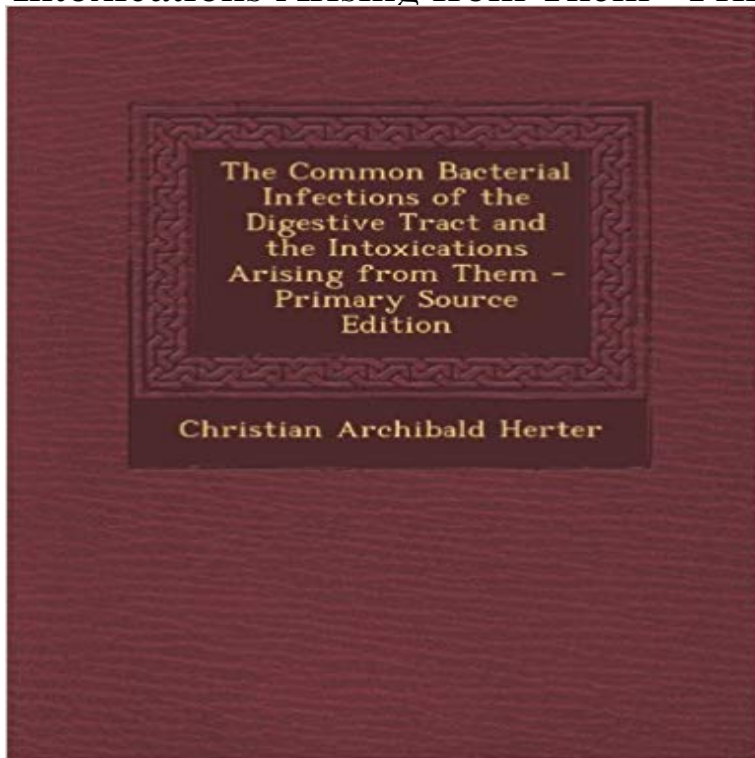


# The Common Bacterial Infections of the Digestive Tract and the Intoxications Arising from Them - Primary Source Edition
