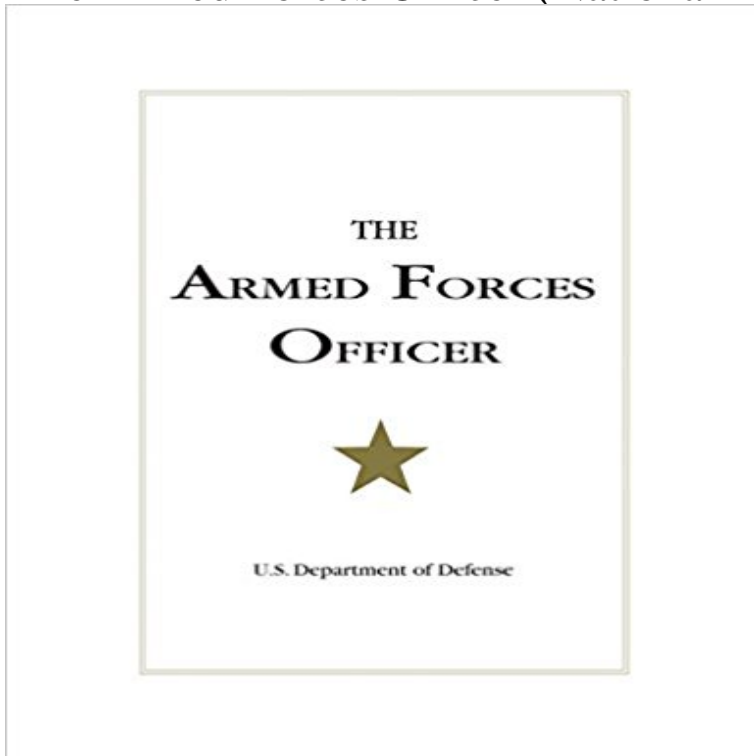


The Armed Forces Officer (National Defense University)
