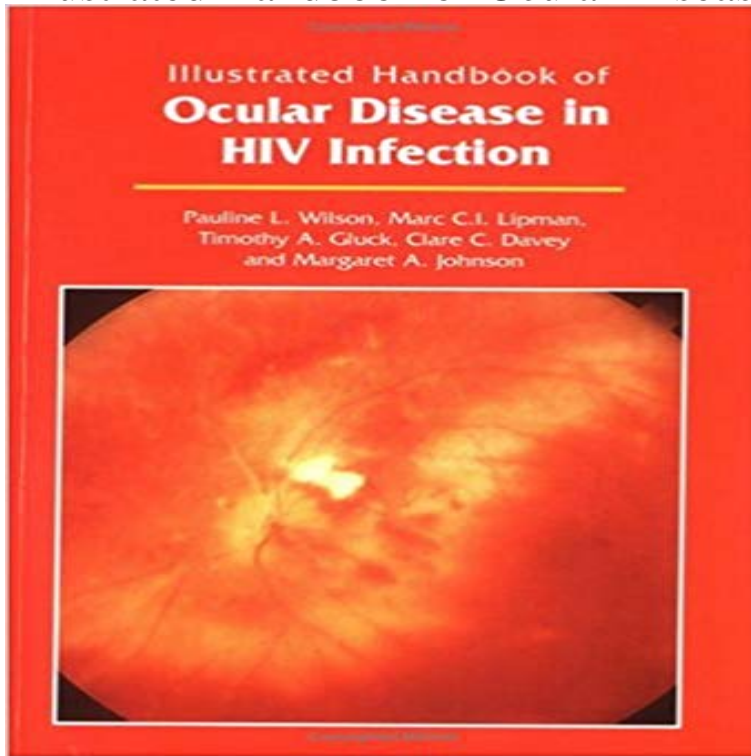


Illustrated Handbook of Ocular Disease in HIV Infection
