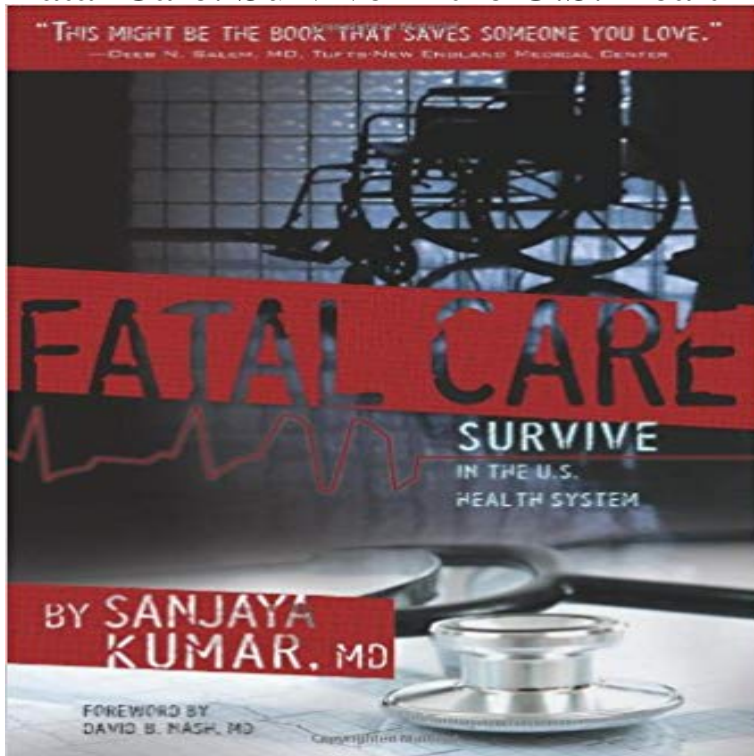


Fatal Care: Survive in the U.S. Health System

Preventable medical errors alone impact or harm at least 5 million Americans annually, costing more than \$17-21 billion.
